

GREAT LAKES RESTORATION INITIATIVE ACTION PLAN II

To guide the continuing efforts of the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI), federal agencies have drafted GLRI Action Plan II, which summarizes the actions that federal agencies plan to implement during FY15-19 using Great Lakes Restoration Initiative funding. GLRI Action Plan II outlines the next phase of work on Great Lakes environmental problems and associated human health issues many of which will take decades to resolve. GLRI Action Plan II lays out the necessary next steps to get us closer to the day when we will be able to achieve our long-term goals for the Great Lakes and our commitments under the U.S.-Canada Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement. GLRI Action Plan II also incorporates a science-based adaptive management framework that will be used to prioritize ecosystem problems to be targeted with GLRI resources and to measure progress and commits agencies to develop and incorporate climate resiliency criteria in project selection processes.
