

## GREAT LAKES PHRAGMITES COLLABORATIVE

The Great Lakes Phragmites Collaborative (GLPC) is a regional partnership established to improve communication and collaboration and lead to more coordinated, efficient, and strategic approaches to non-native Phragmites management, restoration, and research across the Great Lakes basin in both the United States and Canada. The GLPC serves as a communication conduit via an interactive website, a webinar series and social media outlets to facilitate access to information and resources, encourage technology transfer and network building among habitat managers, governmental agencies, and private landowners. This initiative is led by a Core team supported by staff from USGS-Great Lakes Science Center and the Great Lakes Commission with oversight and input from a regional Advisory Committee. This effort is part of a broader USGS project funded through the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative.
